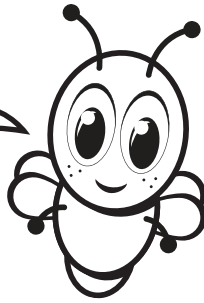


Blinky's Family Challenge

Every Day

We don't know what will happen every day, but God does! Even if we have a bad day, we can trust His plans turn out good in the end.

You'll Need

- A calendar (can be digital, printed, or you can draw your own)

Directions

1. Show your kid the calendar.
2. Talk about how a calendar shows each day that's coming.
3. Point to each day on the calendar and talk about what you hope will happen on those days.
4. Ask your family, "Who really knows what will happen every day?" Help them know the answer is God.

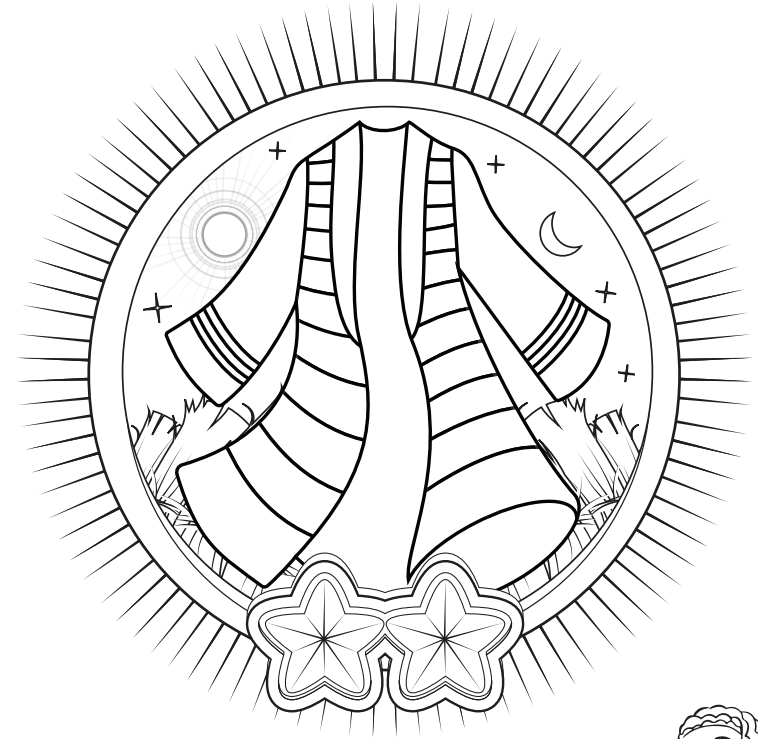

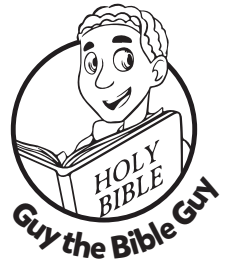

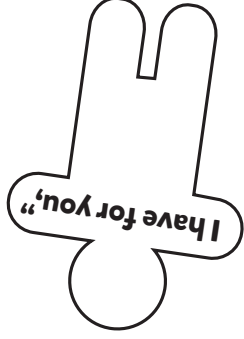
